# FABRIC CARE & STAIN REMOVAL

**Cheat Sheet** 



**GRASS** 

Make a paste with baking soda and white vinegar. Rub in stain and let sit for 15 minutes. Rinse. Reapply if needed.



#### SWEAT

Create a paste with baking soda and water. Rub in Stain. Wash in the hottest water safe for the fabric.



### **BLOOD**

Mix 1 cup (250 ml) water, ½ cup (124 ml) peroxide and ½ cup (125 ml) baking soda. Apply to stain. Let sit for 20 minutes. Wash as usual.



### **CHOCOLATE**

Rub dish soap onto stain and rinse with cold water. Repeat as necessary.



### SAUCE & WINE

Combine equal parts hydrogen peroxide and dish soap. Dab onto stain and let sit for 1 minute.

Wash as usual.



### **OIL & GREASE**

Use a pre-treatment spray or stick, or dish soap, then wash in the hottest water safe for that fabric.



# PAINT & INK

Use solvents, such as acetone, rubbing alcohol or spot remover. Rinse, repeat if needed and finally wash.



### COSMETICS

Pre-treat with stain remover and wash as usual in the hottest water safe for the fabric.



### COFFEE & TEA

Apply stain remover and wash immediately.
Sponge the stain with rubbing alcohol and rinse with cold water.
